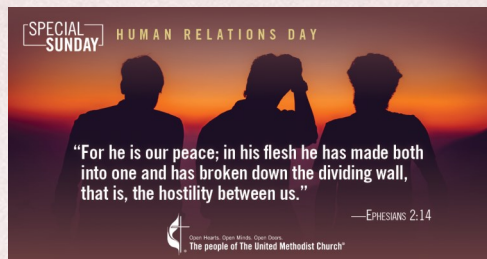

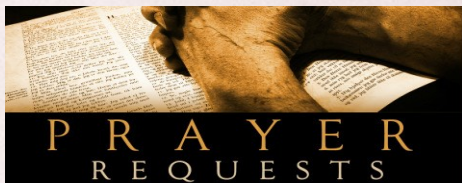

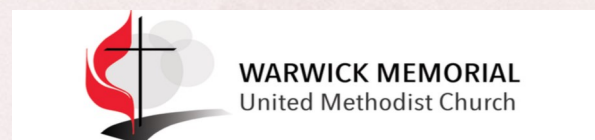
This is a great opportunity to "declutter" your book shelves and to share inspirational reading with others at the same time!
