This week's message will be based on John 4:19-24 Week 3: Spiritual Discipline of Worship

Too often we find ourselves slipping in our worship attendance. However, not only is worship commanded in the Bible, but it is another means of grace where we experience and receive God's unmerited favor. We come to selflessly glorify God, and that same God, being good and gracious, blesses us not only with God's presence, but wisdom and experience. Agua Salada - Our Sponsored Honduras Village through **Friends of Barnabas**

Next Sunday we will commission our 2025 Honduras Medical Mission Team for their trip to Honduras scheduled for February 15th to the 22nd. During their time in Honduras, we are hoping that they will get to visit our sponsored village, Agua Salada; however, the schedules change due to weather and other issues.

Sadly, in 2024, Honduras had a bad dengue epidemic (passed by mosquitos). They had a 445% increase in the number of cases compared to 2023. Thanks to our support for the village of Agua Salada, Friends of Barnabas were able to teach dengue prevention and reported a 60% decrease in dengue cases. The peak time for dengue unfortunately aligned with the peak time for agriculture. FOB staff were able to go door to door so that busy community members could still learn how to prevent dengue. Along with that, Nurse Minerva got her hands dirty while teaching how to divert standing water in the community so it would not attract mosquitos and she was able to teach all ages how to treat the pila (the community water collection basin) with mosquito prevention tablets.
